

BC ELN All Partner Meeting Common Suite Discussion Summary

Overview

The following report provides a summary of the common suite discussion held at the All Partner Meeting on December 8, 2017. Leah Hopton, BC ELN Coordinator, facilitated the meeting. BC ELN partner library director participants are listed below.

Context

Over the past two years, the BC ELN Office, on behalf of partner libraries and with direction from the Steering Committee, has worked to assemble a common suite that will meet system needs. During this process partner libraries have provided feedback through survey comments, phone calls, and at in-person All Partner Meetings. Purpose and Process

The purpose of the 2017 All Partner Meeting discussion was to provide an opportunity for partner library attendees to review information, clarify understandings, and ultimately determine how the Steering Committee should proceed with the common suite.

Leah Hopton facilitated the session using a Liberating Structure (<http://www.liberatingstructures.com>) called W³. Meant to foster inclusion and participation, W³ guides decision-making through three "W" questions: *What happened? (Reviewing the facts)*, *So What? (Discussing the meaning)*, *Now What? (Selecting the action)*. Sitting at round tables of similar institution type and size, attendees actively participated in the process by asking clarifying questions and sharing their perspectives.

BC ELN staff and meeting attendees answered many of the questions that were asked throughout the discussion. Questions that were not answered at the All Partner Meeting were recorded and will be addressed in the FAQ section of the Common Suite Web: <http://bcelnapps.ca/faq-categories/common-suite>.

The discussion concluded with partner library attendees deciding whether to include CBCA, and voting on how the Steering Committee should proceed with the common suite. Partner Libraries agreed to exclude CBCA from the common suite but retain it as an opt-in license.

Common Suite Decision

Partner libraries recommended that the Steering Committee proceed with a common suite containing Academic Search Premier and Business Source Premier with the option of upgrading one to Complete at no additional cost.

Future Considerations

The following themes emerged from the discussion and will be incorporated into future work on the common suite:

1. A clear decision-making process will be developed for approval of any future common suite renewals.
2. Partner libraries are the decision-makers and will be fully involved in the common suite development process.
3. Partner libraries will have the opportunity to review various cost-sharing models.
4. The reduction of tier inequities will be further explored.
